ACCESS TO SCHOOL GROUNDS

The curriculum and instruction program of each school is enhanced by the approved and purposeful involvement of parents and community members. To this end, the Board of Trustees encourages parents and community members to visit school campuses and to become involved in school programs. However, to ensure minimum disruption of the instructional program and to preserve the security of the students and staff, it is necessary to enforce certain regulations pertaining to campus visitors. The regulations are to be developed and enforced by the Superintendent or designee(s) and are not intended to discourage visits by parents and community members.
