DIRECTOR, CONSTRUCTION AND MODERNIZATION

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Plan and organize the construction, reconstruction, and major repair of District facilities and oversee contracted services relating thereto.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Monitor modernization and growth construction projects as directed.
- 2. Represent District at construction, county, and State meetings as necessary.
- 3. Articulate with architect and general contractor to further completion of projects on a day-to-day basis.
- 4. Prepare drafts for review in establishing and maintaining procedures for developing plans to repair, alter, or construct District facilities.
- 5. Prepare drafts for use in the technical development of bid specifications and evaluation of bids.
- 6. Seek out local vendors and coordinate vendor contract approval process.
- 7. Provide on-site assistance for DTSC (Department of Toxic Substance Control) cleanup.
- 8. Assure that bid specifications for repair, alteration, or construction projects, as well as handling and disposal of hazardous waste, are prepared and distributed in a legal and timely manner.
