## ORGANIZATIONAL UNITS AND STRUCTURAL RELATIONSHIPS

The administrative organization of the District shall be considered as an orderly means of achieving the District's primary objective, an effective program of instruction for pupils.

The general administrative organization of the District shall be known as the single executive type of school administration with the Board of Trustees as the governing body and with all activities under the direction of the Superintendent.

Organization or function charts for the District shall be prepared and implemented by the Superintendent to designate clearly the relationships of all employees within the District. The organization or function charts shall be kept up to date.
