JUDICIAL AND OFFICIAL APPEARANCE LEAVE

Judicial and official appearance leave may be granted for purposes of regularly called jury duty, appearance as a witness in court other than as a litigant, or to respond to an official order from another governmental jurisdiction for any reason except those caused by the conduct of the administrator. An administrator granted a Jury Duty Leave under these provisions shall be granted District compensation which, when added to jury duty fee, shall not exceed the administrator's regular District compensation.
