

PROFESSIONAL IMPROVEMENT LEAVE

Professional Improvement Leave may be granted to Administrators for professional study or other professional improvement activities which will benefit the administrator's area of service, or improve his/her individual performance.

The Superintendent may recommend for Board approval Professional Improvement Leave proposals. Proposals must specify the improvement program, duration of leave, and terms of compensation.

An Administrator on Professional Improvement Leave will contribute to retirement, proceed on salary schedule, and be eligible for fringe benefits as are customary for full-time administrative employees.
