## COMPETITIVE FOOD SALES

It shall be the policy of the Board of Trustees to encourage optimal participation in the school lunch program, and school breakfast program, maintained by the District with the objective that nutritionally adequate meals may be provided to students at minimal cost.

Competitive food sales on school premises held during the school day shall be in accordance with Policy No. 5461 and the regulations of the National School Lunch Program.
