

TUBERCULOSIS EXAMINATION: ALL EMPLOYEES

Prior to initial employment, each new regular employee shall have submitted to an examination within the past four years to determine that he/she is free of active tuberculosis. This examination shall consist of an x-ray of the lungs or an approved intradermal tuberculin test which, if positive, shall be followed by an x-ray of the lungs. Each employee is to present results of such examination to the Human Resources Division every four years thereafter.
