

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

A. NEW STUDENTS TO THE DISTRICT

Every student entering the ninth grade, or entering the District as a new student at any grade level, is encouraged to complete a physical examination performed by the student's family physician. The results of this examination should be reported to the school on a District-approved physical examination form.

B. INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC COMPETITION

Every student participating in interscholastic athletic competition shall have yearly authorization by a health professional licensed by the State of California to conduct athletic physical examinations. It is strongly recommended that the physical examination be conducted by a physician holding a valid certificate to practice medicine and surgery in California. Exceptions to the requirement may be made in those cases where the parent or guardian has filed an annual statement with the principal stating that the parent will not consent to a physical examination of the student.

C. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION REPORT FORMS

A uniform physical examination form for the District shall be devised and made available to each school. Forms will be available to the physicians in the North Orange County area.
