EMERGENCY FIRST AID FOR STUDENTS

Each school employee shall render first aid or emergency care as it is needed by a student. If the employee deems it necessary, he shall send for appropriate assistance and shall exercise prudence in determining whether or not the student shall be moved pending the arrival of medical or trained personnel. The employee is responsible for having a basic understanding of first aid and must recognize what he/she can or should not do in an emergency. The Principal shall make necessary provisions for first aid and/or emergency care instruction as needed by the employees.
