

PRIORITY ACCESS

A priority access policy for each of the schools of the Fullerton Joint Union High School District financed in whole or in part by the proceeds of community facilities district taxes shall be established by the Board of Trustees on recommendation of the Superintendent. The Board of Trustees shall review the priority access policy and make adjustments as deemed necessary. Actual Community Facilities District boundary descriptions as set forth by the Board of Trustees shall be kept on file by the Superintendent. In establishing or adjusting priority areas, the Board of Trustees shall be guided by the following criteria:

1. Federal, State, or court mandates.
2. Grade levels for which facilities were designed.
3. Ensuring continuity of schooling within any single school year.
4. Transportation availability and expense.
5. Traffic and safety hazards.
6. Racial/ethnic balance and social-economic diversity.
7. Physical plan adequacies and/or inadequacies.
