

CREDIT/NO CREDIT GRADING

Schools are authorized to use the credit/no credit system for awarding grades to students.

A student with parent, teacher, and counselor approval may elect the credit/no credit status for a course in accordance with criteria established by the principal of each campus. Once credit/no credit for a course has been agreed upon the student may not take it for a letter grade.

The course selected for credit/no credit may not be one of those which the student plans to use to fulfill entrance requirements to the University of California.

Grade point average will be computed only on course credit for which grades have been assigned.
