

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT, AND CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

A high school diploma, certificate of achievement, or certificate of completion shall be awarded to any student only after the student has satisfactorily met the minimum requirements of this District and has been authorized by the Board of Trustees to receive such diploma or certificate.

Although students may earn a "Certificate of Proficiency" under provisions of Education Code Section 48412, such certificate shall not be used in lieu of fulfilling minimum requirements for the awarding of a high school diploma, certificate of achievement, or certificate of completion.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish administrative rules and regulations in order to implement this policy.
