

EXPLOSIVES

Any student who possesses, ignites or discharges an explosive* while on campus or at any school-sponsored function shall be suspended from school. At the end of the period of suspension, the student may be allowed to re-enter the same school or may be transferred to another District school, including La Vista High School. If the incident also involves injury to the property or person of another individual or the property of the District, the student may be referred to the Board of Trustees with a recommendation for expulsion. The use of explosives may be a violation of state or local law. Each violator shall be referred to the fire marshal for appropriate action.

**For this policy, an explosive is considered to include firecrackers and fireworks, ammunition, blasting agents, and any other substance likely to produce noise, smoke, or flash.*
