

VANDALISM

Students shall be responsible for any damage to or loss of school property caused by the student. The parent or guardian of any such student who willfully cuts, defaces, or otherwise injures in any way any property, real or personal, belonging to the school District shall be liable for all such damages caused by the minor. This liability shall not exceed \$2,000. The parent or guardian of a minor shall be liable for all school property loaned to the minor and not returned upon demand of an employee of the school District who is authorized to make the demand. The responsibilities and liabilities described in this policy apply in the matter of books, supplies, equipment, buildings, grounds, and all other school property.

Textbook lockers and gym lockers are made available to students for their use while at school. As lockers are not totally safe from break-in or vandalism, it is recommended that valuables not be left in them at any time.

Personal belongings, school books, equipment, and materials checked out to the student are the responsibility of the student. Neither the school nor the Fullerton Joint Union High School District is responsible for losses occurring from these lockers or from any other location on the campus, whether during the school day or after school hours. Exception to the above may only be made for school books checked out to a student that are stolen or destroyed during school hours when forcible locker entry is clearly identified by the school administrator.
