

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Any student who possesses, furnishes, uses, is under the influence or evinces use of any alcoholic beverage while on campus or at any school-sponsored function shall be referred to the Principal or designee in the absence of the Principal for appropriate disciplinary action. The nature of the action may include, but not be limited to, one or more of the following: expulsion; suspension; transfer to another school; participation in a personal development program related to alcohol use; reassignment to an alternative program; campus and/or community service projects; restriction from participation in school-related activities. At the end of the period of the disciplinary action, the student will be allowed to return to the regular school program or activity. If the incident also involves additional causes for discipline as defined in Education Code Section 48900 and/or any statutory violation, the student may be referred to the Board of Trustees with a recommendation for expulsion.
