## SEARCH AND SEIZURE

The Board of Trustees of the Fullerton Joint Union High School District is fully committed to promoting a safe learning environment and, to the extent possible, eliminating the possession and use of weapons, illegal drugs, and other controlled substances by students on school premises and at school activities. As necessary to protect the health and welfare of students and staff members, as well as to maintain the integrity of student assessment and campus operations and rules, school officials may search students, their property, and/or District property under their control and may seize illegal, unsafe, or otherwise prohibited items, as well as those items reasonably believed to potentially have been used to violate these objectives.

The Board urges that employees exercise discretion and good judgment. When conducting a search or seizure, employees shall act in accordance with law, Board Policy, and Administrative Regulation.
