Schools are authorized to provide one or more of the following programs for students when it has been determined that the student's individual needs can best be met by participation in an alternative program.

Opportunity Program

Online Courses

Although the mode of instruction may vary from that of the regular classroom, the student must meet all graduation requirements in order to be eligible for a diploma and must meet the minimum daily attendance requirements.
