

ADVISORY COMMITTEES

The Board of Trustees recognizes that:

- A partnership between home, community, students, and school is highly desirable in furthering the educational opportunities and achievement of young people.
- Specially designed programs, perhaps more than any regular educational programs, require this close cooperation among these components of society.
- Advisory committees are an important channel of communication in matters pertaining to special programs.
- Services rendered by these committees provide valuable assistance in maintaining and expanding educational goals.

The Board of Trustees establishes advisory committees for compensatory education, special education, and other special programs as required by law and further authorizes school advisory committees for these programs. Each advisory committee will establish bylaws consistent with federal law, State Department of Education regulations, District rules and regulations, and other legal regulations.
