

SELECTION, EVALUATION, AND ADOPTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

The Board of Trustees recognizes the importance of instructional materials in the teaching/learning process. The Board of Trustees intends that the schools of this district be as well equipped and maintained with instructional materials as may be possible within existing financial limitations.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for the development of regulations for selection, evaluation, adoption, and acquisition of basic textbooks, supplementary textbooks, and other instructional materials in accordance with Board policies and the requirements of the California Education Code, and the Fair, Accurate, Inclusive, and Respectful (FAIR) Education Act.
