

BOARD OF TRUSTEES REPRESENTATIVE(S) FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING

The Board of Trustees will designate its representative(s) to represent it in collective bargaining with employee organizations. The collective bargaining process will be conducted on behalf of the Board by its designated representative(s) for collective bargaining.

The Board's role in the collective bargaining process will be to:

- assess, to the best of its ability, the needs of employees.
- set priorities for the total educational program in the best interest of students and the public in general.
- translate educational priorities, perceived employee needs and available resources into realistic parameters for collective bargaining.
- maintain the Board's position of authority and control as provided by law.
