FORMULATION, ADOPTION, AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS

Proposed new bylaws and suggested amendments to or revision of existing bylaws may be adopted by a majority vote of all members of the Board of Trustees. Repeal of existing bylaws shall be by majority vote of all members of the Board. Action on adoption or repeal usually occurs during the second of two meetings of the Board not less than two weeks apart in the calls for which meetings the proposed additions, amendments, or revisions shall have been described in writing.
