Notice of Public Hearing on Intention to Enter into an Energy Services Agreement

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the intention of the Governing Board of the Fullerton Joint Union High School District (“District”) to consider entering into an Energy Services Agreement (“Agreement”) with TOMCO, LLC to upgrade and expand the existing compressed natural (“CNG”) fueling facility at the District Transportation Center located at 1050 South Leslie Street, La Habra, CA 90633 pursuant to the terms of Government Code section 4217.12.

The time and place set for the public hearing on the intention of the Governing Board of the District to consider entering into the Agreement is July 12, 2016 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the Education Center Board Room, 1051 West Bastanchury Road, Fullerton, California. At such time the testimony of all interested persons for or against the proposed Agreement will be heard. Any protest pertaining to the regularity or sufficiency of the proceedings shall be in writing and shall clearly set forth the irregularities and defects to which the objection is made. Any written protest shall be filed with the Clerk of the District on or before the time set for the hearing. The District may waive any irregularities in the form or content of any written notice and at the hearing may correct minor defects in the proceedings. Written protests may be withdrawn, in writing, at any time before the conclusion of the hearing.
